

ENDS Fill In The Blanks

The proper name for a vape is an END, this stands for electronic **NICOTINE** delivery system. This means any electrical device which can give a person nicotine in some way.

Vapes contain a solution known as **E-LIQUID**, this liquid is heated to produce a vapour. The two main types of vapes are, **DISPOSABLE** and **RECHARGEABLE**. Since the disposable vaping ban a new type of vape called **PRE-FILLED** has been created. These are very similar to disposable vapes, meaning the ban has not been as successful as hoped.

To legally buy a vape someone must be **18** or over. If an adult buys a vape for a child this is called proxy **PURCHASING**. As this is illegal an adult can be fined up to £ **5000** for doing this. If a shop sells a vape to a child they can be fined up to £ **20000**.

In the short term, vaping can make a person feel sick, give them a headache and a **COUGH**. In the long term, it is not yet clear exactly what **EFFECT** they have on the body, more time is needed to gather more evidence and research. There have been cases of young people and adults going to hospital for issues with their **LUNGS** and/or **HEART** which is thought to be caused by vaping.

Vapes are very **ADDICTIVE** due to the nicotine inside them which is **PHYSICALLY** addictive. Flavours also make vapes more addictive as people want to use them more as they **TASTE** and **SMELL** appealing. If a person is addicted to nicotine and doesn't get it they can experience **WITHDRAWAL**. If a person has too much nicotine they can get nicotine **POISONING**.
